OBJECTIVE

The purpose of this memorandum is to update the Garden Grove City Council on the City's Third Quarter Sales (July – September 2017) as reported by the HdL Companies.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The City's third quarter (July – September 2017) sales tax report showed a decrease in adjusted gross receipts of 1.6% compared to the same period last year. The year over year quarterly results in the major sales tax receipt categories are outlined below.

- Auto and Transportation decreased 17.8%
- Restaurants and Hotels were up 5.3%
- General Consumer Goods were up 3.4%
- Fuel and Service Stations increased 14.4%
- State and County Pools decreased 4.0%
- Business and Industry were down 19.3%
- Building and Construction down 7.7%
- Food and Drugs were up 4.1%

SUMMARY

Overall, Garden Grove's adjusted gross receipts were down 1.6%, Orange County was up 2.5%, Southern California region increased 3.1%, and the State was up 3.6%. For additional information, please refer to the Garden Grove Sales Tax Update flier attached to the manager memo.

Garden Grove In Brief

Garden Grove's receipts from July through September were 3.6% below the third sales period in 2016. Excluding reporting aberrations, actual sales were down 1.6%.


A onetime accounting adjustment that temporarily inflated last year's allocation caused the drop from used automotive dealers.

The City experienced a decline in sales from new motor vehicle dealers and the business and industry sector. Business closeouts reduced receipts from plumbing/electrical supplies.

The losses were offset by a strong sales quarter for the fuel and service stations group, restaurants and general consumer goods.

Net of aberrations, taxable sales for all of Orange County grew 2.5% over the comparable time period; the Southern California region was up 3.1%.

NOTES

Statewide Trends

After factoring for accounting anomalies, local government's one-cent share of statewide sales and use tax from July through September sales was 3.6% higher than 2016's summer quarter.

Rising fuel prices, increased demand for building-construction materials and the continuing acceleration in online shopping for merchandise shipped from out-of-state that is expanding receipts from the countywide use tax allocation pools were the primary contributors to the overall increase.

This quarter marked the anticipated leveling off of auto sales while agriculture and transit-related purchases helped boost otherwise tepid gains in business-industrial receipts. Restaurant sales exhibited healthy overall gains of 3.5% although growth rates are slowing from previous quarters.

Receipts from consumer goods sold by brick and mortar stores were up 0.7% over the previous year while revenues from online purchases grew 13.3%.

Cannabis Taxation

A 15% excise tax on retail cannabis and cannabis products along with a cultivation tax and sales tax on recreational uses take effect on January 1, 2018.

Significant sales tax revenues are not expected until late 2018-19 as retail start-ups comply with lengthy state and local permitting processes. Although sales of medicinal cannabis became exempt in 2016 for purchasers with a state issued Medical Marijuana ID card, jurisdictions with dispensaries continue to receive sales tax from that source as most patients prefer to use a note from their physicians.

Some decline in revenues from medical dispensaries are expected as users' transition to new purchase options and because of lower prices caused by anticipated overproduction and the six month window that suppliers have to sell existing inventory grown under previous regulations.

Sales Tax and Natural Disasters

The recent firestorm tragedies have raised questions on potential bumps in sales tax revenues from reconstruction and recovery activities.


HdL analyzed the sales tax data from the 1991 Oakland Hills, 2003 San Diego Cedar and 2007 San Diego Witch fires which involved the combined loss of over 7,700 structures. Surprisingly, there were no identifiable gains in construction and auto-related purchases within the impacted areas during the five years after each event with receipts following normal economic cycles experienced by the state as a whole.

Further analysis suggests that though the individual losses are catastrophic, purchases of replacement items are a small fraction of the impacted area's total spending and is often spread to other jurisdictions where disaster victims relocate. Tax receipts from construction spending are defused over time because of lengthy claims and permitting processes that cause up to 40% of disaster victims to relocate leaving vacant lots that are not immediately redeveloped.



We're happy you're here and we welcome you to our city; we've had people in business from South Korea visiting here also," said Stiles. "Does anyone have any tickets to the Olympics they want to give me?"

After translations were made, there were some smiles and chuckles from the students.

Stiles went on to note that Garden Grove is one of 34 cities in Orange County, which is located 30-miles or 42-kilometers south/east of Los Angeles. Garden Grove is the fifth largest with 180,000 residents. It grew from a former strawberry agricultural town into an abundance of homes that have now overtaken the strawberry fields.

"Garden Grove is a very diverse community, with one-third each being Vietnamese, white and Latino and the Orange County Islamic Community is the largest in Southern California," said Stiles. "The diversity of the city is what attracted me to the area and that City Council members.

diversity makes it a special place within the city itself that employs approximately 660 people in all departments including City Hall, Public Works, police and fire departments."

Stiles noted that Garden Grove has its own full-service police and fire departments. "We have a council-manager form of government that is most common in the United States, with a mayor and council members who represent the different districts," he said as he pointed out a large wall with former pictures of mayors in the conference room at City Hall.

The South Korean student ambassadors were in America for a 10-day tour of the Garden Grove and Los Angeles areas of interest.

Each Korean Student ambassador was recognized as an honorary citizen of Garden Grove and each received goodie bags from locations within the city that they toured.

Asked, through an interpreter, how the students felt about being in America and their tour, one said, "It's totally cool," and some said they want to live here because it has a lot of room and the sky and air are clear. One girl said people in America are "Really kind."

Police Capt. Tom DaRe gifted the students with a small memorial-badge pin and they had a photo opportunity with Lt. Amir El-Farra next to a SWAT vehicle along with police patrol vehicles. taking many individual selfie pictures with El-Farra.

"I'm one of the watch commanders and I oversee the police patrol duties," he said.

Biggest event of the year in WM set for Feb. 17

Mark this one on your calendars.

It's a sight to behold, a concert to the ears, and one of the great, historical traditions in Vietnamese culture.

Tet.

"This annual parade is an opportunity to bring together everyone to celebrate cultural diversity and family," said Westminster City Councilman Tyler Diep.

The Tet Parade, celebrating the Lunar New Year, is fewer than three weeks away. On Feb. 17, Little Saigon will be teeming with dancers in colorful costumes, dragons, warriors, drummers and, because it's the Year of the Dog, a pack of police K-9s with their handlers.

Featured in the parade will be people died.

a 55-foot-long replica of a South Vietnamese Navy destroyer that sank in 1974 during a battle against Chinese forces, and a giant TV screen showing a crowd of more than 10,000 — from Westminster, Garden Grove and beyond — the opening ceremonies on the main stage.

As always, firecrackers will be exploding — loudly, but safely.

The replica destroyer is of the Nhat Tao. In 1974, in a battle over the disputed Paracel Islands, the South Vietnamese Navy sank three Chinese destroyers, but the Nhat Tao sank as well, and 75 people died.

a 55-foot-long replica of a South Vietnamese Navy destroyer that sank in 1974 during a battle against "That ship and its crew were outnumbered, yet it sank many invading ships," said Diep.

Diep said China is exercising aggression in the East China Sea today, threatening not just Vietnam but U.S. allies in the region. The Nhat Tao, he said, continues to be relevant.

"It has to do with standing up to outside aggression."

The parade will be broadcast on a couple of local Vietnamese-language television stations, and on Facebook Live and YouTube.

The event, put on by the Vietnamese Federation of Southern California, is scheduled for 8 a.m. to noon on Bolsa Avenue, between Magnolia and Bushard streets.
