Palma Vista Empowerment

The City's Neighborhood Improvement Committee (NIC) is comprised of representatives from several City departments, including Fire, Police, and Public Works.

NIC goals are:

- Coordinate neighborhood meetings and communication
- Explore alternative ways to address neighborhood issues
- Develop strategies to address the physical improvement and social concerns of key neighborhoods

The Garden Grove Palma Vista neighborhood is a multi-family, apartment community made up of approximately 600 residents. Quality-of-life concerns within the neighborhood such as unsightly buildings, crime activity, and poor community involvement, spurred NIC to undertake a multi-year engagement project aimed at partnering with neighbors, businesses, service organizations, volunteers, and other stakeholders to revitalize the area.

NIC facilitated a number of collaborative efforts to engage the community; enhance quality-of-life; and empower neighbors to take ownership. Efforts included neighborhood meetings, community clean-ups, food pantries, planting trees, organizing after-school programs, and even creating a community mural.
