• Size is limited to 3'x18' at all locations except Harbor Blvd., south of Garden Grove Blvd. which is,		
4'x22' maximum. Material, design, method of mounting, and time of display are subject to City		
approval.Banner installations shall be completed by City authors	orized contractor.	
• All banners shall be equipped with harness-type snap fasteners mounted along the top so that the		
banner will slide along the supporting cable. The fasteners must be used in sufficient quantity to adequately support the banner and in no case be spaced more than three feet apart.		
 During installation and removal, no delay shall be caused for vehicles on the roadway. 		
 No part of the display shall be less than 20 feet above the roadway. 		
 Banners must be constructed so as to hang from the supporting cable in such a manner that the bottom of the banner will automatically raise as wind velocities increase, thereby reducing the 		
effective banner frontal area, or;		

• If the bottom of the banner is tied (which would catch wind), the banner shall comply with the

o Provide one, 6-inch diameter wind hold for each 30 square feet of banner area.

Permit Fees/ Deposits

- Permits shall be obtained at least ten (10) working days prior to installation.
- A separate permit is required for each location.
- Permit fee is \$15 each plus a \$35 issuance fee.
- Deposit fee is \$50 for each location. If the City is required to remove or service the banner in any way, the cost of City services will be charged against the deposit. The deposit, less the cost of any City service, is refundable. If the cost of City service exceeds the deposit, the applicant will be billed for the difference.
- Cables and poles are City of Garden Grove property and shall remain intact

I have read and understand the information above. I agree to have the banner installed in accordance with these guidelines. I agree to remove the banner within three days of stated banner removal date. I understand that my deposit is not fully refundable if the City is required to remove or service the banner in any way. If the cost of City service exceeds the amount of the deposit, I agree to pay the difference within thirty (30) calendar days.
