TRANSPORTATION AND HANDLING

- A maximum of 15 gallons or 125 pounds may be transported per vehicle, per trip (Department of Transportation regulation).
- Materials should be in original containers (except motor oil, fuels and antifreeze).
- Containers larger than 5 gallons in size will <u>not</u> be accepted.
- All containers must have lids, be sturdy, non-leaking, and labeled.
- Protect all items from breakage.
- Do not combine different types of waste.
- Do not mix oil-base paint with latex paint.
- Empty containers, with lids removed, can be discarded in trash.
- Household hazardous waste containers will NOT be returned, except for used oil containers in good condition (if requested).
- Personal information and data on computers should be removed or destroyed prior to disposal.
