OBJECTIVE

To request that City Council reject all bids submitted for RFP No. S-1148 - Traffic Control Services for the Garden Grove Open Streets Event on October 12, 2014.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

In support of the Garden Grove Open Streets Event, the Traffic Engineer and the Police Department developed a certified Traffic Control Plan.

Request for proposals to provide, set up, monitor, and remove traffic control devices, RFP No. S-1148 was advertised on August 29, 2014. The City received one sealed bid on September 16, 2014. This bid has been deemed non-responsive as it was missing the required elements.

FINANCIAL IMPACT


There is no impact to the General Fund in rejecting the bids.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council:
