Subject:	APPROVAL OF DONATION OF SURPLUS POLICE UNIT TO GOLDEN WEST COLLEGE CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRAINING CENTER	Date:	October 14, 2014

OBJECTIVE

To secure City Council approval to transfer title of a surplus police unit to the Golden West College Criminal Justice Training Center (Academy).

BACKGROUND

The Academy recently approached the Police Department and requested the donation of a surplus police unit for use in their police academy program.

DISCUSSION

The Academy is one of (2) training academies in the Orange County area from which the Police Department recruits sworn personnel. The Police Department has hired numerous personnel over the years from this program and is satisfied with the quality and level of training of officers that graduate from the Academy.

As part of its regular curriculum, the Academy uses old police vehicles to recreate various training scenarios for recruits to teach and critique their performance. The Academy obtains the vehicles used for these purposes from local law enforcement agencies, and has requested that the City provide a surplus police vehicle. Donation of the surplus vehicle will help enhance the Academy's training of future City Police recruits, thus benefiting the City.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Surplus Police vehicles are sold at auction and result in approximately \$2,200-\$2,500 in gross revenue to the City. Thus, the City would forego this potential revenue in order to make this title transfer.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Approve the title transfer of a surplus Police vehicle to the Golden West College Criminal Justice Training Center.
