Subject: APPROVAL OF A POLICE MOTORCYCLE LEASE AGREEMENT WITH SEAVCO (dba IRV SEAVER MOTORCYCLES)
Date: February 10, 2015

OBJECTIVE

To seek approval from City Council to enter into an agreement with Seavco dba Irv Seaver Motorcycles (Irv Seaver) for a three-year operating lease of nine police motorcycles.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

In July 2011, City Council approved a three-year operating lease with RCA Leasing (dba Long Beach BMW Motorcycles) for nine BMW motorcycles. The lease has been extended on a month-to-month basis until the new motorcycles are in service.

On November 26, 2014, the City released a bid for nine motorcycles to all BMW vendors within a 50-mile radius. Approximately one-week prior, the Purchasing Department contacted these seven vendors asking them to register as vendors, and informed them that the City would soon be releasing a bid for motorcycles. When the bidding closed on December 11, 2014, Irv Seaver Motorcycles in Orange was the one bid that was submitted.

The proposed agreement with Irv Seaver includes nine (9) 2015 BMW R1200 RT-P Police Package motorcycles outfitted to spec per the bid, as well as all mileage-based, manufacturer recommended maintenance for the duration of the lease term. Also included are license and registration fees for each vehicle for the three-year term.

FINANCIAL IMPACT


The monthly cost for nine (9) vehicles is approximately \$7,877, for a total cost of approximately \$283,574 for the three-year term of the lease. Funds are currently budgeted for the remainder of FY 2014-15 and will continue to be budgeted for the duration of the lease term.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the Lease Agreement with Seavco dba Irv Seaver Motorcycles for nine (9) leased vehicles for an amount not to exceed \$283,574.52 for three years; and
- Authorize the Interim City Manager to execute the agreement, and make minor modifications as necessary thereto.
