OBJECTIVE

To secure City Council authorization to purchase one (1) medium duty utility truck from Theodore Robins Ford in the amount of \$79,781.23.

BACKGROUND

Public Works is responsible for providing safe and reliable vehicles for all City departments. The Public Works Department currently has one (1) vehicle that meets the City's quidelines for replacement.

DISCUSSION

Specifications were prepared and sent to bidders in the Orange County area. Six (6) bids were received. Pursuant to Garden Grove Municipal Code Section 2.50.060 and based on the City's Public Works Department recommendations, the Finance Director has determined that the bids received were responsive and are as follows:
