STREET REHABILITATION PROJECTS

OBJECTIVE

For City Council to authorize the appropriation of grant funding totaling \$108,500, received from the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle).

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

In October 2014, the City submitted a grant application to CalRecycle requesting \$108,500 from the Rubberized Pavement Management Program to partially fund rehabilitation work on various street segments.

Per grant guidelines, the work will include the use of asphalt rubber generated from 100% recycled California waste tires to pave three segments on Brookhurst Street and one segment on Westminster Avenue. Work on Brookhurst will begin in August 2015 and work on Westminster will be scheduled at a later date.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no impact to the General Fund. CalRecycle funds will be used for the rubberized portion of the overlay work. Other project elements will be funded by federal grants, Gas Tax and Measure M2.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Authorize the Finance Director to appropriate CalRecycle grant funding in the amount of \$108,500 to the Fiscal Year 2015-16 Budget.
