OBJECTIVE

For City Council to adopt a resolution maintaining eligibility with the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) and certifying the city's financial commitment for future project submittals to the FTIP.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) is a database for programming funding for all state and federally-funded transportation projects and improvements of regional significance. Although the city does not currently have any projects in the FTIP, the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) is recommending adoption of the attached resolution to streamline the grant approval process in the event the city were to become a grant recipient. Should a grant opportunity arise, project matching funds will be allocated through the annual Capital Improvement budget.

Per OCTA, the attached resolution is required from all agencies and must be provided by December 31, 2015.


FINANCIAL IMPACT


There is no impact to the General Fund. The attached resolution is required for future state and federal grant funding.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE CERTIFYING THAT THE CITY HAS THE RESOURCES TO FUND THE PROJECTS SUBMITTED FOR INCLUSION IN THE FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2016/2017 - 2021/22 FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND AFFIRMING THE CITY'S COMMITMENT TO IMPLEMENT ALL THE PROJECTS SUBMITTED TO THE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Garden Grove is located within the metropolitan planning boundaries of the Southern California Association of Governments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has authorized projects submittals to the Orange County Transportation Authority's (OCTA) Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP); and

WHEREAS, the City is the lead agency for projects and will comply with applicable local, state, and federal provisions including but not limited to the Federal Transportation Improvement Program, California Environmental cQuality Act, National Environmental Policy Act, Americans with Disabilities Act, and Buy America; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to construct transportation control measures projects as noted in the FTIP amendments, if these were to occur, in a timely manner.
