OBJECTIVE

To seek City Council approval authorizing the Finance Director to issue a purchase order to Ferguson Waterworks for the procurement of 140 Clow Wet Barrel Fire Hydrants pursuant to IFB No.S-1172.

BACKGROUND

The City periodically purchases and maintains a supply of the Clow Wet Barrel Fire Hydrants in Central Stores for use as needed by the Water Services Division. These fire hydrants will also be used for the Fire Hydrant Replacement Program, which replaces about 140 hydrants annually. This purchase will replenish the necessary inventory of this vital equipment unit and will last approximately six months. The 140 units must be purchased at one time in order to secure the pricing.

ANALYSIS

IFB No. S-1172 was advertised on July 17, 2015, and closed on August 17, 2015. All bids were found to be responsive. The bid results are as follows:

Funds for this purchase are available in the Water Operations Fund, adopted in the FY 15/16 budget. The retired units will be sold at the current scrap metal market value.


RECOMMENDATION
