OBJECTIVE

To request City Council approval of a consent agreement with the Midway City Sanitary District for the purposes of constructing the Newland/Yockey storm drain.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

In 1991 Thielmann Engineers prepared the City's Master Plan of Drainage and identified storm drainage deficiencies. The Master Plan divided the City into seven drainage areas and designated the areas with sequential letters of the alphabet. Drainage area "B" lies in the west-central part of the city bounded by Beach Boulevard and Gilbert Street. Within this drainage area, the Master Plan identifies the Newland/Yockey Storm Drain as the greatest storm drain priority in the City of Garden Grove.

In the process of designing the first segment of the Newland/Yockey Storm Drain, the vertical alignment was found to conflict with a Midway City Sanitary District (MCSD) sewer in Oasis Avenue. Since both facilities are gravity-operated systems, design modifications were required to allow the proper operation of both. The modifications to the facilities have been designed to the satisfaction of MCSD and the City.

To formalize the understanding between MCSD and the City, a cooperative agreement has been prepared to the satisfaction of the parties, and was approved by the MCSD Board of Directors. The agreement is now ready for consideration of the Garden Grove City Council.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The proposed action has no financial impact to the general fund. The project construction will be funded through Community Development Block Grant (Fund 161) and Drainage Fees (Fund 082).

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COMMUNITY VISION

This project is consistent with the community vision for maintaining and enhancing the city's infrastructure assets to maximize their value, longevity, and usefulness for the community.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Authorize the Mayor and the City Clerk to execute the agreement with the Midway City Sanitary District to modify and maintain Midway City Sanitary District sewer facilities affected by the future construction of the Newland/Yockey Storm Drain
