The remaining action for the City Council is to hold the protest hearing and, after conducting the hearing, adopt the attached proposed Resolution for the fiscal year 2008-09.

The impact to the Main Street Assessment District No. 1 is an assessment of \$27,700.00 or \$19.92 per linear front foot of the Main Street property owners. There is no impact to the City's general fund.





RECOMMENDATION


Staff recommends that City Council adopt the attached proposed Resolution:
