OBJECTIVE

To receive authorization from City Council for the City Manager to execute a contract with R.J. Noble Company of Orange, CA for 3.2 center lane miles of Street Rehabilitation (Overlay) for the fiscal year 2008.

BACKGROUND

Selected streets for the 2008 Overlay have been identified, and reviewed. Preparation work for the Overlay is in progress with an anticipated completion date of August 2008. Proposition 42 City Aid Program (CAP) funding will be used to fund the Overlay. The Purchasing Division was requested to advertise for bids for the project.

ANALYSIS

In response to prescribed bidding procedures, the following bids were received:

The Streets Division examined the bids received and determined that the lowest responsible bidder is **R.J. Noble Company Orange, CA.**

FINANCIAL IMPACT


Funding for this project is available through a CAP Grant. A termination clause has been included in the contract, should funding become unavailable.


COMMUNITY VISION IMPLEMENTATION

RECOMMENDATION

- It is recommended that City Council award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, R.J. Noble Company, for the Street Rehabilitation (Overlay) Prop 42 CAP Project in the amount not to exceed \$548,850.20.
- Authorize the City Manager and the City Clerk to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.
