RECOMMENDATION TO AWARD CONTRACT FOR LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR

RFP NO. S-1023 to S.C. YAMAMOTO

### **OBJECTIVE**

To recommend that the City Council award a contract for landscape maintenance services at City parks, medians, frontages and well sites.

## **BACKGROUND**

The current landscape contract with S.C. Yamamoto Inc. has been very flexible for the City. It has allowed the City to add or delete properties as it has become necessary. It also allowed the City to assign maintenance on an as-needed basis at a favorable hourly rate. This practice will continue through the next signed contract.

The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2010, with an option to extend said agreement for an additional eight (8) years, for a total performance period of ten (10) years. Option years shall be exercised two (2) years at a time, at the sole option of the City. The City without cause may terminate this agreement.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Staff requested proposals from thirty-three (33) contractors to provide landscape maintenance services to City medians, well sites, frontages, and parks. Out of those thirty-three (33), only six (6) responded, with one company later withdrawing from the process. Three staff members rated the final submitted proposals on the basis of qualifications and total cost. The following is a summary of the ratings, with the highest total being the most qualified, of the remaining contractors:

Upon selection of the most qualified contractor, Facilities staff interviewed S.C. Yamamoto Inc., and negotiated an agreement for its services.

# FINANCIAL IMPACT

The impact to the general fund in the Facilities Division budget for the next 10 years is \$1,276,940.00.

This contract does not include an annual CPI adjustment. Instead, the contractor has adjusted the cost for performing services on a biannual basis as part of his bid proposal (Attachment 3).

# COMMUNITY VISION IMPLEMENTATION

Safe, clean, medians, parks and landscaped areas are essential to meeting the quality of life element outlined in the Strategic Plan adopted by the City Council.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that City Council:

- Award the contract to S.C. Yamamoto Inc., to perform landscape maintenance services at selected properties throughout the City, with a total price of \$117,698.00 per year during the first two years of the agreement.
- Authorize the City Manager and City Clerk to execute the contract agreement on behalf of the City.
