FOR TRASK AVENUE REHABILITATION

Date: July 22, 2008

OBJECTIVE

To award a contract for the Trask Avenue Rehabilitation from Magnolia Street to Euclid Street.

BACKGROUND/ DISCUSSION

The project consists of grinding existing pavement two inches deep, crack sealing and pavement preparation along with the construction of asphalt concrete inlays with pavement fabric. The project will require traffic control, replacement of traffic striping, and replacement of traffic signal loops. The proposed street rubberized asphalt project will significantly improve ride and appearance of Trask Avenue and enhance and maximize their longevity.

ANALYSIS

Five (5) bids were received and opened in the City Clerk's office at 3:00 p.m. on July 8, 2008. The lowest qualified bidder is Hardy & Harper, Inc., with a total bid of \$ 1,226,550.00. This bid is within the current project budget.

The licenses and references of the contractor have been reviewed and verified by staff, and all other documentation is in order. The anticipated contract schedule is as follows:

Begin construction (estimated) August 11, 2008

Complete construction (estimated) September 5, 2009

COMMUNITY VISION IMPLEMENTATION

This project is consistent with the community vision for maintaining and enhancing, the city's infrastructure assets to maximize their value, longevity, and usefulness for the community.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact to the general fund. This improvement is included in the 2007-08 Capital Improvement Budget and is funded by Measure "M" regional (fund 423) and California Integrated Waste Management Board Funds.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Award contract to Hardy & Harper, Inc. for \$ 1,226,550.00.
- Authorize the City Manager and City Clerk to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.
