OBJECTIVE

For the City Council to accept and appropriate grant funds awarded by the TET Festival 2008 Community Assistance Fund.

BACKGROUND

Each year, the Union of Vietnamese Student Associations of Southern California (UVSA) establishes the TET Festival Community Assistance Fund using proceeds from their annual TET Festival in the City. The UVSA seeks to provide financial assistance to various community programs and projects.

DISCUSSION

In April 2008, Staff submitted an application to the UVSA requesting funds to assist in the funding of the City's Project Go Graffiti Abatement Program. Subsequently, the UVSA has awarded the City \$1,000. Funds will be used to purchase paint and supplies for the Project Go volunteers.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are no matching funds required for the grant program; therefore, there is no impact to the General Fund.

COMMUNITY VISION IMPLEMENTATION

This grant project will assist in ensuring that Garden Grove remains an attractive community to all groups.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that City Council:
