TRANSPORTATION FUNDING FOR THE CITY'S INTERNATIONAL WEST HARBOR

BOULEVARD PROJECT

OBJECTIVE

To request City Council approval of a resolution supporting funding for the City's International West Harbor Boulevard Project through the reauthorization of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU).

BACKGROUND

For approximately the past year, the City has been working to obtain funding for transportation improvements along Harbor Boulevard through the reauthorization of the federal highway transportation bill, SAFETEA-LU. It is expected that the reauthorized bill will provide over \$290 billion for surface transportation throughout the nation when Congress reauthorizes it in 2009.

The City's contract lobbying firm, Federal Advocates, has assisted the City in developing a \$78.6 million project proposal and economic analysis in support of this effort (see attachments 1 and 2). To date, various meetings, briefings and site visits have been conducted with key legislators, legislative staff, and Committee staff to introduce, review, and discuss the City's International West Harbor Boulevard Project.

DISCUSSION

Staff is presently working with Federal Advocates to generate and document support for the project. As part of this effort, it is recommended that the City Council adopt a resolution supporting funding through the reauthorization of SAFETEA-LU and urging our distinguished members of Congress to fully fund the International West Harbor Boulevard Project. The resolution will document and make it publicly known that the City's request is fully supported at the local level.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact.
