Agenda Item D.3. Red Curb - 12011 Winton Street - May 5, 2009

OBJECTIVE

To consider a red curb request at 12011 Winton Street.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The City received a request from two residents in the surrounding neighborhood to address a traffic safety problem at the intersection of Chapman Avenue and Winton Street, an uncontrolled T-intersection. The residents stated that motorists traveling eastbound on Chapman have difficulty seeing oncoming cars on Winton approaching the intersection from the south. This problem is caused by a recreational vehicle that is regularly parked at the intersection in front of 12011 Winton Street.

On March 30, 2009 staff field reviewed the site and discussed the problem with the property owner, Jane Moats. She stated that she was aware of the complaints and that she would have the recreation vehicle removed from the area by the beginning of the following week. Staff indicated that, if necessary, red curb would have to be installed to ensure public safety. To date, the recreational vehicle has not been removed.

RECOMMENDATION


