Subject:	COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER FOR THE REHABILITATION OF BUSHARD STREET	Date:	May 26, 2009

OBJECTIVE

To approve the Cooperative Agreement between the City of Westminster and the City of Garden Grove for the rehabilitation of Bushard Street from Hazard Avenue to Westminster Boulevard and to authorize the Mayor and the City Clerk to execute the agreement.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The City of Westminster has been awarded a grant through Proposition 1B for the rehabilitation of Bushard Street from Hazard Avenue to Westminster Boulevard. Approximately one-fourth of the work lies within the City of Garden Grove. The City of Westminster has offered to improve the City of Garden Grove’s portion.

This agreement will be for construction costs and construction administration of Garden Grove's portion of the project. The City of Westminster is serving as lead agency.

Staff has reviewed the plans and specifications of the project, including the location of Garden Grove's portion. The total project cost for Bushard Street is estimated at \$190,786.75.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funding required for the project has already been approved in Fiscal year 08/09 budget. There will be no impact to the General Fund.

COMMUNITY VISION IMPLEMENTATION

This project is consistent with the community vision for maintaining and improving the transportation system to ensure the safe, efficient flow of traffic.

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REHABILITATION OF BUSHARD STREET



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RECOMMENDATION
