

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial impact is \$32,571.76 to the Vehicle Maintenance operating budget. This fund was developed to ensure funding for equipment when the equipment has fully depreciated and is no longer cost effective to maintain. The financial support for this purchase is provided by assessed funding over the last four years from the General Fund, and deposited into the Vehicle Maintenance Replacement Fund. The surplus vehicle will be sold at auction.


COMMUNITY VISION IMPLEMENTATION
