RECOMMENDATION TO AWARD CONTRACT

OBJECTIVE

To award a contract for the construction of the Harbor Boulevard/ Trask Avenue Intersection Improvement Project.

BACKGROUND

The proposed project will widen the west side of Harbor Boulevard to its ultimate width to allow for four southbound through lanes and two left turn lanes. Additional improvements include construction of curb and gutter, sidewalk, driveway, wheel chair ramps, median curb, aggregate base, asphalt concrete, cold planing existing asphalt, water meters, storm drain catch basins, fire hydrant, traffic signal modification, traffic detector loops, red light camera modifications, traffic striping, raised pavement markers and adjusting utility valves and manholes to new finish grade.

DISCUSSION

Nine (9) qualified bids were received and opened in the City Clerk's office at 11:00 a.m. on June 10, 2009. The lowest qualified bidder is Elite Bobcat Service, Inc., with a bid of \$495,000.00. Subsequent to the bid process the City determined that the demolition of a gas station will also be required at an additional cost of \$132,530.00. This bid is within the current project budget. The licenses and references of the contractor have been reviewed and verified by staff, and all other documentation is in order. The anticipated contract schedule is as follows:

Award contract Begin construction August 25, 2009 September 21, 2009

Complete construction

December 21, 2009

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact to the general fund. This improvement is included in the 2008-09 Capital Improvement Budget and is funded by Measure "M" local (fund 421), Measure "M" regional (fund 423) and Gas Tax (fund 061).
