**OBJECTIVE**

To receive City Council approval to enter into an agreement with Pavement Coatings Incorporated for on-call slurry seal.

**BACKGROUND**

The Public Works Department in conjunction with its regular street maintenance program performs annual slurry seal operations. Typically, a slurry seal treatment will protect and add approximately three to seven years of service life to a street. In our efforts to sustain and/or further lengthen the service life of our streets, Public Works Staff has determined that the use of Type III REAS Slurry Seal would be to our advantage to use in various locations of our City.

**DISCUSSION**

IFB No. S-1052 was advertised on July 15, 2009, and re-advertised on July 22, 2009. The bid document was posted on the City's website on July 15, 2009, via the Planet Bids on-line bidding system. There were 36 notified bidders for this project. On August 14, 2009, one bid was received and opened. Bid result is as follows:
