Subject: PURCHASE ORDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF CLOW WET BARREL HYDRANTS Date: January 26, 2010

OBJECTIVE

To seek City Council approval authorizing the City Manager or his designee to issue a purchase order to the apparent low bidder, D'Angelo Company for the procurement of Clow Wet Barrel Hydrants pursuant to IFB No. M-1002.

BACKGROUND

The City periodically purchases and maintains a supply of these fire hydrants in Central Stores for use as needed by the Water Services Division. These fire hydrants will also be used for the Fire Hydrant Replacement Program, which replaces about 140 hydrants annually. There are approximately 30 currently on hand in the Central Stores Warehouse. This purchase will replenish the necessary inventory of this vital equipment, and will last approximately six months. The 140 units must be purchased at one time in order to secure the pricing.

ANALYSIS

IFB No. M-1002 was issued and advertised on November 20, 2009 and was re-advertised on November 27, 2009. The bid document was posted on the City's website on November 20, 2009 via the Planet Bids on-line bidding system. There were 42 notified bidders for this project. No addendums were issued.

The bid results are as follows:

All bids were found to be responsive.


FINANCIAL IMPACT


Funds for this purchase are available in the Water Operations Fund, adopted in the FY 09/10 budget and the retired units will be sold at current market scrap metal value.
