OBJECTIVE

For City Council to accept the above project as complete and authorize the Mayor to execute the Notice of Completion of Public Improvement and Work.

BACKGROUND

The project included the removal and reconstruction of failed pavement areas, concrete median curb, colored concrete, curb and gutter, sidewalk and wheel chair ramps, asphalt concrete overlay, traffic striping and raised pavement markers on Harbor Boulevard from Garden Grove Boulevard to Chapman Avenue.

DISCUSSION

The contractor, All American Asphalt, has completed the improvements in accordance with the plans, specifications and other contract documents. The project was 100% funded through Federal Stimulus Fund (fund 361).

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact to the general fund. The subject project was completed within the project budget and schedule. The retention payment will be released after recordation of the Notice of Completion.



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Garden Grove, Orange County, California, has caused a public improvement, to wit:

HARBOR BOULEVARD REHABILITATION**

to be constructed upon the property hereinafter described. The contract for furnishing of all plant, labor, services, materials, and equipment, and all utilities and transportation, including power, fuel, and water, and performing all work necessary to construct and complete, in a good and workmanlike manner in strict accordance with the specifications, plans, and drawings therefore on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Garden Grove, for the construction, installation and completion of the above-described public improvement and work, was heretofore made and entered into with All American Asphalt, on the 8th day of December, 2009, and filed for record in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Garden Grove; that the work upon said public improvement has been completed, and that the City Engineer has notified the City Council that he has made and completed a final inspection of the materials furnished and installed and the work performed in the construction, installation, and completion of said public improvement hereinabove more particularly described and set forth, and has certified in writing to the City Council that all the provisions of the contract and contract documents for the furnishing of all plant, labor, services, materials, and equipment, and the performing of all work necessary for the construction, installation, and completion of said public improvement above described have been fully complied with to his satisfaction as required by the contract document; that final acceptance of the construction, installation, and completion of said public improvement above described was made on the 24th day of August, 2010 that the nature of the title to said property of said City of Garden Grove is as follows: That is to say, it owns said public improvement in fee except the right-of-way upon which it is constructed, and that it owns an easement upon, over, and along said right-of-way for the purpose of the construction, installation, and completion of said public improvement hereinabove described and the use thereof after said completion; that the property hereinabove referred to and on which said public improvement is situated is described as follows, to wit:


