On December 31, 2010, after 33 years of decorated service to law enforcement, 12 to the City of Garden Grove, "Chief Joe" will proudly don his Police Chief uniform and badge for the last time, as he retires from the Garden Grove Police Department with all the honors deserving of a proven leader, mentor, and professional, who will preserve a cherished standing in the Garden Grove community.
