OBJECTIVE

To request that the City Council approve parking limitations and signage at Pioneer Park for Power Play Sports participants during hockey programming hours.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

In May 2010, the City extended the License Agreement with Power Play Sports (PPS) for the operation of the hockey rink at Pioneer Park. Since 2004, PPS has operated and delivered quality programs to the community of Garden Grove.

Overflow parking issues exist at Pioneer Park as a result of North East Garden Grove Little League participants, who are permitted by Garden Grove Unified School District to use the fields at Warren Elementary School, parking at Pioneer Park, instead of the School.

City staff is recommending parking on the east side of the Pioneer Park parking lot be designated as parking for PPS participants during the hockey program days and hours, which are Sundays from 1:00–5:00 p.m., Wednesdays from 5:00–10:00 p.m. and Thursdays from 5:00–10:00 p.m. Signs identifying the parking restrictions will be posted. Violators will be subject to a \$44 parking fine for violation of Section of 10.56.130 of the Municipal Code.


FINANCIAL IMPACT

The approval of parking limitations and signage at Pioneer Park has no financial impact to the City's current fiscal budget. The City will continue to receive rent based on the established formula outlined in the Agreement with PPS. Funds are available for the minor cost of the additional signage.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Adopt the attached Resolution establishing parking restrictions for the east side of the Pioneer Park parking lot allowing only Power Play Sports (hockey) participants to park during hockey program days and hours; and
- Authorize staff to post signs at Pioneer Park regarding the parking restrictions.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE
AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS AT
THE PIONEER PARK PARKING FACILITIES

WHEREAS, under California Vehicle Code Section 22519 and Garden Grove Municipal Code Section 10.56.130, the City is authorized to prohibit, restrict, or regulate parking on any City-owned or City-operated parking facility;

WHEREAS, under California Vehicle Code Section 22519 and Garden Grove Municipal Code Section 10.56.130, any parking regulation proposed by the City may not take effect until signs giving notice of the parking regulation are in place;

WHEREAS, under California Vehicle Code Section 40200(a) and Garden Grove Municipal Code Section 10.100.020(a), the City may impose a civil penalty for the violation of such parking regulations upon the listing such penalties in the City's schedule of parking violations fines; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to address parking issues located at the Pioneer Park parking facilities by implementing parking restrictions that facilitate parking for the use of certain community and recreational activities at Pioneer Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Garden Grove hereby resolves as follows:

Section 1. That parking restrictions are hereby implemented designating and restricting parking spaces on the east side of the Pioneer Park parking lot for participants in the hockey programs of Power Play Sports participants during such hockey program days and hours.

Section 2. That signs shall be installed at the restricted parking spaces at Pioneer Park giving notice of such parking restrictions.

Section 3. That the City's schedule of parking violation fines shall include a fine in the amount of forty-four dollars (\$44) for the violation of such parking restrictions.
