Subject: ALLOCATION OF FY 2011-12 STATE SUPPLEMENTAL LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES FUNDS Date: August 23, 2011

OBJECTIVE

To request that the City Council hold a Public Hearing, and approve the use of the State Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Funds (SLESF) for FY 2011-12 allocation of approximately \$310,000.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

SLESF funding for local government is currently included in the Governor's proposed State of California FY 2011-12 Budget. This allocation assists local agencies by providing additional resources for law enforcement programs or capital items, and is not intended to supplant current funding. Last year, City Council approved SLESF funds for the purchase of equipment to enhance the investigative capabilities of the Investigations Unit, improve preparedness and communications in the Mobile Command Center, and to equip officers with protective gear during real-life training scenarios.

For FY 2011-12, the Police Department is asking the City Council to approve approximately \$310,000 in SLESF funding to fund a number of equipment purchases for the Police Department. All of the purchases will be for equipment used to support front-line law enforcement personnel in the performance of their duties.


FINANCIAL IMPACT


SLESF funds are specifically for law enforcement purposes only, and their use will have no impact on the City's General Fund.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Conduct a Public Hearing; and
- Approve the allocation of \$310,000 in SLESF funds for the future purchase of equipment used to support front-line Police Department personnel.
