LOCATIONS AND FIBER OPTIC COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM

OBJECTIVE

To award a contract for the Construction and Installation of Amber Alert Dynamic Message Signs at two locations and Fiber Optic Communications System.

BACKGROUND/ DISCUSSION

Plans and specifications for the above project were approved by the City Council on February 14, 2006. The project consists of the following:

- 1. Installation of two (2) Amber Alert Dynamic Message Signs. One sign will be installed for northbound Harbor Boulevard north of Flagstone Avenue. The second sign will be installed approximately 300' north of Tiffany Avenue on Valley View Street for northbound traffic.
- 2. Install Fiber Optic Communications System from Amber Alert Dynamic Message Signs to the Traffic Management Center inside City Hall.

Nine (9) qualified bids were received in the City Clerk's office at 3:00 p.m. on November 28, 2007. The lowest qualified bidder is Moore Electrical Contracting, Inc., with a total bid of \$2,565,621.00. This bid is within the current project budget. The licenses and references of the contractor have been reviewed and verified by staff, and all other documentation is in order. The lowest three bidders are as follows:
