### OBJECTIVE

To award a contract for the construction of the following street rehabilitations:

**BROOKHURST STREET** from GARDEN GROVE BOULEVARD to LAMPSON AVENUE  
**BROOKHURST STREET** from WESTMINSTER AVENUE to TRASK AVENUE  
**CHAPMAN AVENUE** from DALE STREET to MAGNOLIA STREET  
**CHAPMAN AVENUE** from WEST STREET to HARBOR BOULEVARD  
**GARDEN GROVE BOULEVARD** from EUCLID STREET to NEWHOPE STREET  
**GARDEN GROVE BOULEVARD** from GILBERT STREET to BROOKHURST STREET  
**GARDEN GROVE BOULEVARD** from NEWHOPE STREET to HARBOR BOULEVARD  
**MAGNOLIA STREET** from WESTMINSTER AVENUE to TRASK AVENUE  
**NEWHOPE STREET** from WESTMINSTER AVENUE to TRASK AVENUE  
**WEST STREET** from CHAPMAN AVENUE to ORANGEWOOD AVENUE  
**WEST STREET** from LAMPSON AVENUE to CHAPMAN AVENUE

### BACKGROUND/ DISCUSSION

The project consists of the removal and replacement of existing failed pavement areas, milling of existing pavement, crack sealing and pavement preparation along with the construction of asphalt concrete inlays with pavement fabric. The proposed improvements also include the removal and replacement of concrete sidewalk, curb, gutter, drive approaches, cross gutters, wheel chair ramps, and new concrete bus pads. The project will require traffic control, replacement of traffic striping, and replacement of traffic signal loops. The proposed street rehabilitation projects will significantly improve ride and appearance of these eleven arterial streets and enhance and maximize their longevity.

### ANALYSIS

Eight (8) bids were received and opened in the City Clerk's office at 3:00 p.m. on November 29, 2007. The lowest qualified bidder is R. J. Noble Company, with a total bid of \$ 5,593,058.90. This bid is within the current project budget.

The licenses and references of the contractor have been reviewed and verified by staff, and all other documentation is in order. The anticipated contract schedule is as follows:

<i>Begin construction (estimated)</i>	<i>January 22, 2008</i>
<i>Complete construction (estimated)</i>	<i>December 30, 2009</i>

#### COMMUNITY VISION IMPLEMENTATION

This project is consistent with the community vision for maintaining and enhancing, the city's infrastructure assets to maximize their value, longevity, and usefulness for the community.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact to the general fund. This improvement is included in the 2006-07 Capital Improvement Budget and is funded by Gas Tax (fund 061), Measure "M" local (fund 421) and Federal Funds.

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Award contract to R. J. Noble Company for \$ 5,593,058.90.
- Authorize the City Manager and City Clerk to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.
