CONTRACT TO PACIFIC COAST CABLING, INC. TO INSTALL FIBER

OPTICS AT VARIOUS CITY LOCATIONS

OBJECTIVE

City Council authorization to award a contract to install fiber optics at various City facilities.

BACKGROUND

Over the past several years, the Traffic Engineering Division of the Public Works Department has installed fiber optic cabling to many traffic light signals throughout the City. Staff has determined that this fiber network, if extended, can be used at a variety of Fire Stations and City and Water facilities to replace current data connects back to City Hall and the City Yard respectively. The fiber network will be more efficient and will eliminate annual service and maintenance costs associated to the existing data connections (wireless, DSL, and leased lines).

RFP No. S-1073 was advertised on March 25th, 2011.

DISCUSSION

Five (5) proposals were received and opened on May 6, 2011. The Source Selection Committee (SSC) review scores were completed on April 7, 2011. The analysis below indicates the Proposal Pricing and the SSC scores:

The SSC committee ranked Pacific Coast Cabling, Inc. dba PCC Network Solutions highest because they offered a work plan that best fit the needs of the City, received positive references, and offered pricing that was more competitive than the other four proposers.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial impact for this project is \$127,349.77. This amount will be funded by the Information Technology's contractual services budget and the Public Works water fund.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- Award a contract to the highest scoring proposer, Pacific Coast Cabling, Inc. dba PCC Network Solutions, in the firm fixed price of \$127,349.77; and
- Authorize the City Manager to sign and execute the Agreement, including making any modifications during the contract period for the operation and implementation of the contract services.
