A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDEN GROVE  
AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF ALL APPLICATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE) RUBBERIZED PAVEMENT  
GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code Sections 40000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board, to administer the Rubberized Pavement Grant Program in furtherance of the State of California's (State) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment;

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the Rubberized Pavement Grant Program;

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, the City Council of the City of Garden Grove to declare by Resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the Rubberized Pavement Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Garden Grove will maintain and operate the property acquired, developed, rehabilitated, or restored for the life of the resultant facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Garden Grove authorizes the submittal of all annual applications to CalRecycle for the Rubberized Pavement Grant Program for which the City of Garden Grove is eligible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Garden Grove hereby authorizes the City Manager or his designee to execute in the name of the City of Garden Grove all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and requests for payment necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorizations are effective for five (5) years from the date of adoption of this Resolution.
