This is your opportunity to learn skills that will assist you, your family and your neighbors with everyday life emergencies, as well as enable you to assist the community-at-large in the event of a major disaster or emergency.

The C.E.R.T. course is taught twice a year by Garden Grove Fire Department, in conjunction with the Garden Grove Police Department. The curriculum is presented in four Saturday sessions conducted at the North Net Training Facility from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. Training involves the following:

- C.E.R.T. Organization/N.I.M.S. (National Incident Management System)
- Fire Safety
- Disaster Medical Operations Part 1
- Disaster Medical Operations Part 2
- Light Search and Rescue Operations
- Disaster Psychology
- Terrorism
- Disaster Simulation and Graduation
