


Atlantis Family Campout

Aquatics Programs

SWIM PROGRAM (For All Ages)

The 2007 Summer Aquatics Program (June, July, and August) includes American Red Cross swimming lessons and recreational swimming at four pool locations throughout the City. The swimming lessons emphasize the development of swimming skills to promote personal safety, health and exercise, as well as social interaction.

Pools will open Monday, June 25, 2007, for swim lessons and recreational swimming. To schedule a pool rental, or for more information on the summer program call 741-5200.

Registration will be conducted on a first-come, first served basis as class capacity allows. Fees are payable at the time of registration. Swim classes are held Monday through Thursday, forty minutes each day for two weeks. Each session is \$40/43 per student. Checks are made payable to the City of Garden Grove. Visa and MasterCard will be accepted. There will be a \$5.00 processing fee for each refund. MUST REGISTER IN PERSON. Class registration for the swimming program will be conducted throughout the swimming season as follows:

BASIC SWIM CLASSES

All pools

Ages 6 months-5 years

PARENT & CHILD (\$40/43)

Designed to develop in your child a high comfort level in and around the water and a readiness to swim. Skills include water adjustment, blowing bubbles, underwater exploration, back float, prone glide, to safety skills. The course does not teach children to be accomplished swimmers or to survive in the water. Use of play as a basic form of learning provides fun and enjoyment in the water. One adult, 18 years of age or older, must accompany the child in the water.



TINY TOTS (\$40/43)

Ages 3-5 years

Introduce swimming and water safety to children of pre-school ages who are comfortable in the water without parental assistance or floatation devices. The class is for new swimmers who need to learn safe water entry, breath control, float on front and back, swim with some support on front and back, and water safety skills.

LEVEL 1 - Introduction to Water Safety (\$40/43)

Age: Not Younger than 5 (without permission of the instructor)

Designed for children with limited swimming experience, but who are comfortable in the water without parental assistance. Helps children build confidence and develop safety skills in and around the water. Some of the skills to be learned are front and back floats, and swim on front and back short distances by themselves.

LEVEL 2 - Fundamental Aquatic Skills (\$40/43)

Age: Not younger than 6 (without permission of the instructor)

For children who can float, put their head under water, and swim short distances by themselves. New skills include learning a combined stroke on front and back, swim on side, glide, roll over, fully submerge to retrieve object, bob, tread water, and water safety skills.

LEVEL 3 - Stroke Development (\$40/43)

(Must have completed and passed Level 2)

For the child who can swim both the front and back strokes at least 5 yards. New skills include the butterfly kick, jump into deep water, tread water, survival float, development of coordinated front and back crawl strokes, reaching assist and other water safety skills.

ADVANCED SWIM CLASSES High School Pool only

LEVEL 4 - Stroke Improvement (\$43)

(Must have completed and passed Level 3)

Child should be comfortable swimming in deep water at least 15 yards using both the front and back crawl. New skills include safe diving, underwater swimming, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly, improved distance and confidence in the front and back strokes, throwing assist, and other safety skills.

LEVEL 5 - Stroke Refinement (\$43)

(Must have completed and passed Level 4)

Child must be able to swim 25 yards of both the front and back crawl, 15 yards elementary backstroke and breaststroke, and tread water for 1 minute. This class provides further coordination and refinement of strokes along with new skills such as sidestroke, surface dives, flip turns, survival swimming and rescue breathing.

LEVEL 6 - Swimming and Skill Proficiency (\$43)

(Must have completed and passed Level 5)

Child must be able to swim 50 yards of both the front and back crawl, 25 yards elementary backstroke and breaststroke, and tread water for 2 minutes. Student will continue to refine swim technique, do swim conditioning and endurance, safety and survival skills, and basic springboard diving techniques.

SQUAD (\$23)

Ages 4-16 years

Child must be able to swim 25 yards in at least one competitive stroke, such as freestyle or backstroke. Students will work on swim team related techniques, and have the opportunity to enter swim meets.

WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR AIDE (\$33)

Ages 10-17 years

(Must have completed and passed Level 4)

Designed for those who want to assist the Water Safety Instructor with swim classes. Students will work on instructional responsibilities, emergency plans, non-swimming rescues. This class is eighty minutes long.

GUARD START (\$33)

Ages 11-14 years

(Must have completed and passed Level 4)

Provides a foundation of life guarding and life skills for youth with good swimming skills, who wish to become Lifeguards. This class is eighty minutes long.

BASIC WATER RESCUE (\$33)

Ages 12 years and older

(Must have completed and passed Level 4)

Provides individuals with the information and skills necessary to prevent, recognize, and respond to aquatic emergencies. Small craft safety will also be discussed.

WATER POLO (\$90, Additional Family Members \$60)

Ages 9 to 14 years

Achieve a better understanding of water polo as you practice and improve fundamental techniques such as ball handling, catching, passing, shooting, offensive and defensive positioning tactics and team concepts. Participants must be able to swim proficiently in deep water and need to have completed a Level 4 swimming class or pass a swimming test. No class on July 4, 2007.

Camp Garden Grove Summer Day Camp

Camp Garden Grove is supervised by trained recreation leaders. The program provides a variety of weekly activities including group games, crafts, sports, music, special excursions, cookouts, and more! A new theme and a major excursion is planned for each of the ten weeks of the program. Mini trips are also included on a weekly basis to add to your child's enjoyment. A calendar of activities will be distributed on Monday of each week with times of departure and arrival for excursions and information on other special activities.

Deposit: For each week of day camp desired, a \$5 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is required and must be paid by June 21, 2007. After June 21, full payment will be required to register for each week. No exceptions. Payment must be made prior to the first day of camp. No payment is accepted at the camp site.


Counselor-In-Training: This program is designed to promote an interest in camp leadership through structured responsibilities as a Junior Counselor. CITs are assigned to a Counselor and act as a Junior Counselor for a group of up to ten children. Responsibilities include assisting with arts and crafts, games, excursions, and special events. Interested youth, 13 years and older, must submit an application to the Recreation Office and complete the interview process. The fee is \$35 per week. Applications must be received by May 24, 2007, and will not be accepted during the summer months.

Special Events and Outings: Each week's theme is celebrated through a special event day complete with games, a cookout, and a themed event. In addition, each week a variety of recreational experiences are available including swim days at a city pool and special outings in the community.

Every camper is encouraged to participate in Camp Garden Grove's reading program. Each Monday begins with a trip to the local library where campers can check out exciting books to read during the week. At the end of each week, campers are given a special award recognizing their reading progress.
