CUP-572-01</u> – The Applicant, Trails End RV Storage, is requesting a modification to Conditional Use Permit No. CUP-572-01 to allow for an eight-foot-high block wall to replace the required five-foot-wide landscape planter along the east side of the Trails End RV Storage facility located on the Southern California Edison easement and the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way, between Chapman Avenue and Lampson Avenue, east of Western Avenue.

On April 3, 2003, the City Planning Commission, pursuant to Resolution No. 5354, denied the modification to CUP-572-01. An appeal was filed by the applicant on April 24, 2003, and public hearing on the case was ordered by the City Council to be held this date.

5.b. PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT NO. PUD-100-03 AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT FOR SITE PLAN NO.
