### Citrus Greening Disease Found in Garden Grove



The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) confirmed the presence of the citrus disease huanglongbing (HLB) from citrus trees tested in a residential neighborhood in Garden Grove. The infected trees were removed and a 5-mile quarantine has been established in the areas.

CDFA crews will continue to go door-to-door to check for HLB in Garden Grove. If you suspect your tree has the disease, call CDFA at (800) 491-1899.

### Grove District Welcomes "High Lifestyle" Hotels

During the Mayor of Garden Grove's 2018 State of the City address, he announced two new "high lifestyle" hotels coming to the Grove District—Anaheim Resort, adjacent to the Target store on Harbor Boulevard: Le Meridian and Kimpton.

With hotel resorts across the U.S., Europe, and the Caribbean, the Garden Grove Kimpton hotel will offer



200 rooms, 10,000 square-feet of meeting space, two restaurants, and a rooftop pool with a lounge and bar.

Paris-borne Le Meridien, with locations worldwide, brings nearly 400 rooms, two restaurants, 30,000 square-feet of meeting space, and a rooftop bar to guests staying in the resort area.

The development occupies a 4.3-acre site and is considered the City's largest development project to date. Construction is anticipated for the second half of the year, with completion in 2021.

## Garden Grove Strawberry Festival & Strawberry Stomp 5K

Garden Grove's namesake Strawberry Festival celebrates "60 Years of Fun and Funding Charities." The 4-day event is held during Memorial Day weekend,

## A Safe, Sane, and Fine-Free 4<sup>th</sup>

The Garden Grove Police and Fire Departments are strongly urging the public to follow the “No Illegal Fireworks, \$1,000 Fine” policy on July 4. Violators to the City’s Municipal Code on illegal fireworks can receive a \$1,000 citation for possessing illegal fireworks, or even misusing or tampering with legal ones.

Police officers, firefighters, and volunteers from the Garden Grove C.E.R.T. (Community Emergency Response Team) will be looking out for illegal fireworks on Independence Day. All parks will close by 5 p.m., and tennis courts, basketball courts, and softball fields will also be locked at that time. Park sprinkler systems will be activated at 6 p.m.

In accordance with Garden Grove Municipal Code firework regulations, discharge of fireworks is permissible on private property only. For more information, please call the Garden Grove Fireworks Hotline at (714) 741-5270.

## New Laws Promote Construction of ADUs

ADU or Accessory Dwelling Unit (also referred to as a “second unit” or “granny unit”) is an attached or detached residential dwelling unit situated on the same parcel as an existing primary single-family dwelling. This unit provides complete independent living facilities for one or more persons, including permanent provisions for living, sleeping, eating, cooking, and sanitation.

Recent state legislation eases various legal provisions to promote the development of ADUs, including allowing ADUs to be built concurrently with a single-family home, and reducing parking requirements.

Keeping waste off the ground is not just about being considerate to your neighbors and their lawns – it's also about protecting the environment, your family, and the community.

## Simple Water Safety Steps Can Save Lives

Your greatest water safety assurance comes from adopting and practicing as many safety steps as possible. Adding an extra safety step around water can make all the difference. You can never know which safety step will save a life – until it does.



### Stay Close, Be Alert and Watch

- Always watch your children and never leave them unattended
- If a child is missing, check the pool first
- Share safety instructions with family, friends, and neighbors

### Learn and Practice Water Safety Skills

- Learn to swim
- Know how to perform CPR on children and adults

- Understand basic life saving skills in case of an emergency

### Have the Appropriate Equipment

- Install a fence around the perimeter of the pool and spa of at least 4 feet in height
- Use self-closing and self-latching gates
- Ensure the pools and spas you use have compliant drain covers
- Maintain pool and spa covers in working order
- Have life-saving equipment such as life rings or reaching poles available for use



# Summer Swim Programs

## SWIM PROGRAM

Pools will open Monday, June 18, 2018. The 2018 Summer Aquatics Program includes American Red Cross swimming lessons and recreational swimming at our pools throughout the city. The lessons emphasize the development of swimming skills to promote personal safety, health and exercise, as well as social interaction. Pool rentals and other swimming opportunities are also available. For more information about the summer program, call (714) 741-5200.

### SWIM LESSONS

Swim lessons consist of eight (8) lessons, held Monday - Thursday, for 40 minutes each day for two consecutive weeks. The fee for a basic group session is \$50 per student. A basic series of four (4), 40-minute private lessons is \$85 and will be offered based on instructor availability.

Registration will be conducted on a first-come, first-served basis as class capacity allows. Fees are paid at the time of registration by credit card, check or cash. If paying with cash, please bring small bills. A request for a refund must be made one week prior to the start of class. There is a \$5 processing fee for each class refund.

## SWIM CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

### **PARENT & CHILD (\$50)**

*Ages: 6 months-4 years*

Parents and children participate in guided practice with emphasis on fun, comfort, and swimming readiness. This course does not teach children to be accomplished swimmers nor to survive in the water. Swim diapers are required. One adult, 18 years of age or older, must accompany the child in the water.

### **PRE-STAR (\$50)**

*Ages: 2-3 years*

This 20 minute class introduces children to the pool in a class environment. Emphasis is on cooperation with the instructor and learning basic motor skills in the water, which guides and prepares them for the Starfish class. Swim diapers are required.

### **STARFISH (\$50)**

*Ages: 3-5 years*

This class is for new swimmers younger than six years of age. Introduces swimming and water safety to children with little or no previous swimming experience who are comfortable in the water without parental assistance or floatation devices. Swim diapers are recommended.

### **TADPOLE (\$50)**

*Ages: 4-5 years*

For children younger than six years of age who can independently float on front and back with minimal support, and swim 9 feet unassisted.

### **SEA TURTLE (\$50)**

*Ages: 4-5 years*

For children younger than six years of age who have passed Tadpole. Child can start from the wall and swim 15 feet of front crawl, and do an independent back glide.

### **GUPPY (\$50)**

*Ages: 6 years and up (Not younger than six)*

Introduction to water safety for children with limited to no swimming experience. Helps children build confidence, swim on front and back short distances by themselves, and develop safety skills in and around the water.

### **SEAL (\$50)**

*Ages: 6 years and up or for children who have passed the Guppy or Sea Turtle level*

This class is for children who can swim more than 15 feet by themselves. New skills include learning a combined stroke on front and back, tread water, and water safety skills.

### **DOLPHIN (\$50)**

*Ages: 6 years and up or for children who have passed the Seal level*

Designed for children who can swim both front and back strokes at least 30 feet, jump into deep water and tread water. New skills include the development of coordinated strokes, diving, and more safety skills.

### **PRIVATE LESSONS**

Individual instruction for all ages is available in a series of four (4) lessons, 40 minutes in length. Private for one is \$85. Semi-private for two is \$110.

# Save Your Community's Citrus

*A Deadly Plant Disease and Dangerous Pest Have Been Found in California*

The California citrus we all know and love is at risk. A devastating plant disease called Huanglongbing, also known as HLB or citrus greening, has been found in Southern California. HLB kills citrus trees and there is no cure. Diseased trees produce bitter, hard and lopsided fruit, and eventually die. The disease is spread by a pest called the Asian citrus psyllid as it feeds from tree to tree. Psyllids are small, about the size of an aphid, and can be seen on the small, tender, new leaves of citrus trees. The best way to protect California citrus from the disease is to stop the spread of the pest.

## *We All Play a Critical Role:*

- Inspect your citrus trees monthly for the pest and disease.
- Do not move citrus plants, leaves or foliage in or out of your community, or across state or international borders.
- Cooperate with agriculture crews placing traps, inspecting trees and treating for the pest.
- Talk to your local nursery or garden center about products that can protect your tree from the Asian citrus psyllid.
- Plant citrus trees from reputable, licensed nurseries in your area.
- When grafting trees, only buy registered budwood with source documentation.
- Control ants on your citrus trees. Ants interfere with beneficial insects and actually protect the Asian citrus psyllid. Talk to your local nursery about ant bait that can help.
- If you no longer wish to care for your citrus tree, consider removing it so it does not become a host to the pest and disease.
- If you suspect your tree has the psyllid or disease, act fast! Call the California Department of Food and Agriculture at **800-491-1899**.




