



# SCOMMUNITY PROFILE


Centrally located in Orange County, California, the city of Garden Grove (17.8 square miles) is home to over 175,000 residents and is a friendly, spirited, and balanced California community rich in diversity -- a city with a view to the future.

Garden Grove is the fifth largest city in Orange County and is conveniently located less than one mile from the Disneyland Resort, 12 miles from local beaches, and 30 miles from Downtown Los Angeles. Incorporated June 18, 1956, the city was founded in 1874 by Dr. Alonzo Cook.

# **CITY SERVICES**

#### POLICE DEPARTMENT



The Garden Grove Police Department is an internationally-accredited law enforcement agency. The department has grown from 27 officers in 1956 to over 138 sworn members today. The mission of the Garden Grove Police Department, through Community Policing, is to improve the quality of life in the city and provide a sense of safety and security to the community.

# FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Garden Grove Fire Department was established in 1926 to provide services designed to minimize loss of life and property. Since its inception, the Fire Department has expanded its role of fire suppression to emergency medical services and technical rescues, which provide a higher level of protection for the citizens of Garden Grove.



# COMMUNITY SERVICES



The Community Services Department offers year-round programs that provide a full range of opportunities for life enrichment, self-improvement, personal growth, and artistic expression for all ages.

The Community Meeting Center, Courtyard Center, and park facilities may be rented for private functions.

# PARK FACILITIES/GOLF COURSE

Garden Grove has 21 parks, the Gem Theatre, the Festival Amphitheater, an indoor sports complex, picnic facilities, play areas, pools, sports fields, and golf course.

Located in Santa Ana, and five miles west of Disneyland, Willowick Golf Course is owned by the City of Garden Grove. The 18-hole public golf course offers two sets of tees, grass driving range, three practice putting greens, a pro shop, a PGA Class A professional on staff, affordable green fees, and a full-service bar and restaurant. 3017 W 5th Street, Santa Ana, CA 92703







Health services in the city include a range of physicians and specialties, including veterinary services.

An upgraded and expanded Kaiser Permanente provides trusted medical care for the community. Garden Grove Hospital Medical Center has been repeatedly named among the "Top 100 U.S. Hospitals" in the nation by Truven Health Analytics, based on quality of care and patient satisfaction. The Joint Commission also named it one of the nations top performers on key quality measures.


# **BUSINESS**

#### **BUSINESS LICENSE TAXES**

The business license applicant initially pays \$68.50 in taxes and fees for their business license. Additional taxes on all gross receipt revenue in excess of \$50,000 are paid at the end of the business license year. If the business does not generate gross receipts of \$50,000+ during the previous business license year, the renewal payment is \$53.50.


#### **Brookhurst Place**
