## TRAFFIC INCIDENTS CONTINUE TO BE THE LEADING CAUSE OF DEATH IN GARDEN GROVE

Distracted drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists not following traffic rules have led to an increase in fatal traffic accidents.

The Garden Grove Police Department Accident Reduction Team was organized as part of a City campaign to reduce traffic collisions and the number of fatalities in Garden Grove.

In 2016, the Garden Grove Police Department received a \$249,100 grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety for a year-long program of special enforcement and public awareness efforts to prevent fatal traffic accidents.
