
CRIME TREND:

FOLLOW-HOME ROBBERIES

Safety is paramount, whether you're at home, work, or driving around the city.

Prevent follow-home robberies and burglaries by reviewing the following safety recommendations:

- Avoid displaying anything of value, such as money, purses, watches, and jewelry.
- Before exiting your car, look for anything out of place.
- Keep trees and shrubs near doors and windows trimmed. While landscaping may be used to increase your privacy, it provides coverage for a burglar.
- Don't hide keys in a "secret" place outside your home. Burglars know where to look.
- · Don't have your home address on your key ring or leave your house keys or garage door opener in your unattended vehicle.



Consider starting a neighborhood watch program to help keep your neighbors connected and updated of pertinent information.

DROWNING PREVENTION

While water activities can be fun, they can also be very dangerous. Drowning is the leading cause of death for young children. As the summer months approach, make sure to stay alert while playing in and around water.

Follow these water safety tips:

- Install a self-latching gate around all sides of the pool.
- Designate a water watcher who will be free of distractions and will call 9-1-1 in case of an emergency.
- Learn CPR and water rescue skills, such as using a shepherd's hook and life ring.
- Never swim or play near water alone.
- Always keep children within arm's reach.

The City of Garden Grove has public pools at Woodbury Park and Eastgate Park.
